2025 Lutheran Summer Music Academy & Festival

Lutheran Summer Music Academy & Festival (LSM) is a faith-based residential music academy for students in grades 8-12. Students come together from all over the country to immerse themselves in joyful music-making and build a supportive and welcoming community, living together on a Lutheran college campus. During the day, students receive advanced musical instruction through large ensembles (Festival Band, Choir,

and Symphony Orchestra), chamber music, private lessons with collegiate-level faculty, and elective classes (such as conducting, composition, church music, jazz, musical theatre). At night, students attend recitals and Evening Prayer services, and social events with friends. LSM 2025 takes place at Valparaiso University in Indiana from June 22-July 20 (Full Session) or June 22-July 6 (Half Session) and is open to students who have completed grades 8-12. Members of Grace Lutheran Church and students at Grace Lutheran School are eligible for a scholarship to attend LSM for just \$250, plus the application fee.
