Finance Report

Grace Lutheran Church General Fund – July 1, 2025 through December 10, 2025 (23 Sundays)

- Church Budgeted Contributions \$889,000 (\$38,650 per week)
- Church Actual Contributions \$763,000 (last year was \$727,000 through December 10)
- Church giving is \$126,000 (14.2%) behind budget, and \$36,000 (5.0%) ahead of last year.
- Today's December 10 deficit is \$213,000 (\$225,000 deficit last year through December 31).
